PASSPORT ISSUE FOR MINORS (under 18)

- All passport applicants, regardless of the age, must attend the Consulate in person
- Children under the age of 18 must obtain consent by both parents even in case of separation, divorce, de facto or adoption:
 - If one of the parent is not an EU passport holder, both parents will need to attend the appointment and a fee will apply for authentication of signature (for a list of updated fees click [here](#))
 - In case both parents are EU passport holders, one of the parent has the option of submitting the application on behalf of both, presenting the consent form (see below) signed by the parent that will not attend the appointment
- If the applicant's birth certificate has never been registered, it is mandatory that the request of registration is submitted at least a week prior to the passport appointment. For more information click [here](#).

- Two passport- sized photographs (obtainable from the Australian Post Office)
- Current Italian Passport (if available), or (where possible) other proof of ID
- Copy of ID of both parents (EU passport where applicable)
